
General recommendations

- Assessing quality based on the official objectives of the HEI
- Quality assurance must include students and staff, with personal and professional development as main purpose
- Mutual recognition of professional qualifications of mobile staff should be developed at formal level
- Focus on teachers' language skills as professional development

General recommendations (continued)

- Clearly assign the responsibility for mobilities' quality
- Improvement of soft skills (team-work, negotiation, mediation, problem-solving, interpersonal skills, flexibility and good communication)
- Strengthen the cooperation between home and host HEI
- Make available sufficient funding for increasing the quality and quantity of mobility
- Develop a blog with successful mobility stories

Assuring quality for STUDY MOBILITIES



INCOMING STUDENTS

- Develop an international curricula (in English) and make it compatible with partners' structures
- Use all the available channels to promote the university, city and country (online, offline, opinion leaders)
- Increase quality through direct involvement of IRO personnel, local students
- Organize events welcome week, cultural evenings, trips, scientific debates and ask for feedback

OUTGOING STUDENTS

- Use all the available channels to promote mobility and inform students about the future mobility (online, offline, students, teachers, exchange)
- Choose qualitative partners by using personal contacts and provide concrete information about the partner university
- Organize international conferences for students
- Assure full recognition of ECTS credits
- "Sell" the experience and the professional value through former students
- If needed, provide language courses

Assuring quality for PLACEMENT MOBILITIES



- Sign agreements with reputable companies, institutes and different entities
- Develop the agreements portfolio through the assistance of partner universities
- Creation of national data base with placement opportunities
- Develop qualitative relationships with local branches of the international companies
- Promote the mobility as a mean to acquire competences
- Asses the student before the placement, together with the company
- Assure full equivalence of the mobility
- develop joint collaboration between professors and company representatives for thesis / master dissertations

Assuring quality for TEACHING MOBILITIES



- Identify matching fields of expertise and common academic ideas
- Organize a transparent and qualitative selection for participants based on the expected outcomes
- Short feedback report where the beneficiary presents the outcomes to colleagues
- Development of new scientific networks
- Development of new teaching programmes in foreign languages

Assuring quality for STAFF MOBILITIES



- participation in staff training weeks, job-shadowing and trainings
- contribution to promotional materials for those going abroad
- priority in selection given to young teachers and academic staff, as well as to those who haven't benefited before of a mobility
- feedback questionnaires, sharing feedback and experience
- ambassadors of home universities
- internationalization should be prioritized by participants due to the positive effects both at personal and institutional level

BEST PRACTICE



<u>Lectures and workshops with international</u> <u>guests from partner universities</u>

- Fist edition, 2014: 13 participants, 3 fields of education
- Second edition, 2015: 15 participants, 3 fields of education
- Third edition, 2016: 40 participants, 9 fields of education, 19 countries of origin
- Financed through: the City hall of Sibiu, within the Cultural Agenda of Sibiu and personal funds of LBUS



- 54 lectures held by international guest in all the 9 faculties of LBUS
- 1 internationalization workshop with administrative personnel and academics
- Cultural trips and events
