INTERNATIONALISATION OF HIGHER EDUCATION IMPOSE:

- develoning of strong relationship between:
 - Programmes
 - Institutions
 - national and regional policies and
 - strategies from each country

REALITY:

There is no universally applicable model in terms of how to approach and implement internationalisation in I.H.R

ARGUMENT:

 Rationales, policies and governance structures change over time, and the interaction between the different levels and stakeholders in higher education and its internationalisation - including employers, given the increased emphasis on employability in relation to internationalisation

I.H.E. - REGIONAL LEVEL

- Talking about I.H.E. Is imperative to prospect:
 - The regional level
 - Global level (we live today in globalization)

I.H.E. - REGIONAL LEVEL

- Over the past decade, the emphasis in Europe has moved from the national level, to the institutional level on the one hand and the European Union on the other.
- we can observe a revival of national policies - in Europe, for instance, internationalisation policies have been introduced in:
 - Germany, the Netherlands, Norway, Poland, the UK and Romania (in preparation)

I.H.E. - GLOBAL LEVEL

- •A similar trend has been seen outside of Europe as well, for example in:
 - Australia,
 - Canada and
 - South Africa (in preparation)

INTERNATIONALISATION AT STUDENT AND STAFF MOBILITY LEVEL

- My colleagues already offer this details
- Important:
 - last years we increase the number of agreements with universities:
 - we have EU-partners partners (France, Italia, Norway, Nederlands, Spain, Bulgaria, Czech Republic, Poland, Denmark, Croatia, Austria, Germany, Finland, Greece)
 - but also in preparation from other area (eg: Japan, Israel, Turkey)

PROGRAMES:

- Scientific research:
 - Partenership in future educational projects
 - Conferences / workshops
 - Summer schools
