Cisnadioara: village settled at the foot of the Cibin mountains, settlement documentary mentioned in 1204. Saxon settlers. Medieval architectonic ensemble (XIII-XVIII century); museum; monument of architecture in Roman style, the oldest in the country (1223, Cisnadioara)
